Clinton informed the Board of the options for the next steps to extend the Historic Preservation Tax Credits and other benefits to more property owners in the Village of Springville. These steps towards expanding access to the State Historic Homeownership Tax Credit Program are priorities for funding from the SHPO's Certified Local Government Program and the Preserve NY program of the Preservation League of NYS.

The Board was presented with six (6) different options which could help up to ninety (90) more properties to be added to the existing twenty-six (26) properties already on the National Register.

After much discussion, the Board has decided to recommend option #4 of the 6 options to the Village of Springville Board. – see attached. (A.1)

Motion was made by Donald Orton, seconded by John Baronich to recommend the Village conduct a Windshield Survey of Potential Springville Main Street National Register Historic District then create a National Register Historic District combining the East and West End of the Local Historic District, The East Main-Mechanic Streets National Register Historic district and the potential West Main Street National Register Historic District. All in favor, none opposed.

Acting Chairman Skura asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the January 12, 2016 meeting.

John Baronich made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Helen Brogan. All in favor, none opposed.

Don Orton made the motion to adjourn at 8:450 pm, seconded by John Baronich. All in favor, none opposed.
