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Chairman Batterson talked to the board about the Sign issue at the property owned by M&T Bank. The sign for the bank was approved back on December 13, 2011, but the Bank Manager Joanne was very disappointed with the outcome. After dealing with the Sign Company for several months, Joanne decided not to go any further with this. A new Certificate of Appropriateness would be needed due to the length of time that has passed if they want to reopen discussion.

Chairman Batterson talked about the East Hill Run District. He informed the board that owners of property in that district can apply for Tax Credits. This district is controlled by the State and National Register and not our local Historic Preservation Board.

Trustee Orton asked about the property located on the NW corner of Woodward and S. Central. He mentioned that the Christian Youth Group might be able to assist the owner in some needed repairs if he/she was financially unable to afford these repairs.
