The area that this grant would affect would be East and West Main Street. After discussion, motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Chamberlin and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to accept the 2016/2017 NY Main Street Grant in the amount of \$300,000.
