After the Pledge of Allegiance, Acting Chairman Skura called the meeting to order at 8:00p.m.

Acting Chairman Skura then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the September 8, 2015 meeting.

Don Orton made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Helen Brogan. All in favor, none opposed.

The first Certificate of Appropriateness came from David Petrosewitz from Reid Petroleum/Crosby Mart located at 6 E. Main Street. Reid Petroleum is looking to re-locate its Trash Corral from the South Side of the building to the North Side.

After some discussion, Acting Chairman Skura asked for a motion.

Don Orton made the motion to approve the application as presented, seconded by Helen Brogan. All in favor, none opposed.

The second Certificate of Appropriateness came from Thomas Tisdell from Tom's High End located at 19 W. Main Street. Thomas is looking to put up a Sign at his place of business.

The third Certificate of Appropriateness came from Kim Carrow from My best Friends Closet located at 65 E. Main Street. Kim is looking to put up an Awning at her place of business.

After some discussion, Acting Chairman Skura asked for a motion.

Helen Brogan made the motion to approve the application with a suggestion that she paint the building black just over the awning, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.

The fourth Certificate of Appropriateness came from Panda House located at 57 W. Main Street. They are looking to have two (2) signs approved.

After some discussion, Acting Chairman Skura asked for a motion.

Don Orton made the motion to approve with the stipulation that a decorative boarder be placed around the sign that is on the W. Side of the building, seconded by Helen Brogan. All in favor, none opposed.

The last Certificate of Appropriateness came from The Concord Historic Society for the Heritage Building addition on Franklin Street.

After some discussion, Acting Chairman Skura asked for a motion.

Helen Brogan made the motion to approve the application as presented, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.

Don Orton wanted to thank everyone for changing the time of the meeting from 7pm to 8pm to accommodate his schedule for that evening.

Helen Brogan made the motion to adjourn at 8:45pm, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.
