A Special Meeting of the Trustees of the Village of Springville was held at the Village Office at 5 West Main Street, Springville, New York at the above date and time. Present were:

Mayor Krebs called the meeting to order at 4:30 PM.

1. 65 Franklin Street Bid Awards After explanation and discussion and recommendation from Brian Kulpa, engineer from Clark Patterson Lee the following bids are awarded as detailed below.

Motion was made by Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Wikman, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the General Construction bid (bid opened 5/12/16) to Northern Dreams Construction of Buffalo, NY in the amount of \$942,000 (base bid of \$955,000 deduct Alternate GC-04 \$13,000).

Motion was made by Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Moriarty; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Moriarty, Wikman and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the Mechanical Construction bid (bid opened 3/22/16) to Mazza Mechanical Services of Olean, NY in the amount of \$202,000.

Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Moriarty and Chamberlin voting yes, none opposed to awarding the Plumbing Construction bid (bid opened 3/22/16) to MKS Plumbing Corp. of West Seneca, NY in the amount of \$106,500.

Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Moriarty; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Moriarty, Chamberlin and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the Electrical Construction bid (bid opened 3/22/16) to Industrial Power and Lighting Corp. of Buffalo, NY in the amount of \$247,600.

The total amount of all bids are \$1,498,100.

2. Adjourn Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Chamberlin, Wikman and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to adjourn the Special Meeting at 4:40 pm.
