After the Pledge of Allegiance, Chairman Batterson called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Chairman Batterson then asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the October 11, 2016 meeting.

Helen Brogan made the motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.

The first Certificate of Appropriateness came from Ted and Kathy Winkey. They are the owners of the property located at 3 E. Main Street. They are looking for approval to put Awnings up at the property. The Awnings would go over three (3) second story windows facing E. Main Street along with the Entrance on E. Main Street and the Handicapped Ramp on the S. Buffalo side of building. The Awnings would be Black in color and would have an overhang of approximately 4 ft..

After much discussion, Chairman Batterson asked for a motion.

John Baronich made the motion to accept as presented, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.

The second Certificate of Appropriateness came from William Schneider from Salem Lutheran Church located at 91 W. Main Street. The church is looking to install a LED Sign in conjunction with the existing sign.

After much discussion, the board decided to TABLE this Certificate of Appropriateness. The board needs to look further into the use of LED Signs. This has never been requested in the Historic District before and they don't want to make a decision until they do more investigating.

Don Orton made the motion to TABLE the Certificate, seconded by John Baronich. All in favor, none opposed.

The board reviewed the CLG Audit Summary for the period of 10/1/11 to 9/30/15. We met all of the standards. The report is a good teaching tool moving forward.

John Baronich made the motion to adjourn at 8:15pm, seconded by Don Orton. All in favor, none opposed.
