

## YOU ARE HEREIN *OFFICIALLY* NOTIFIED THAT IT IS ILLEGAL TO PARK ON ANY VILLAGE STREET

**Report:**

Recommend resolution to authorize Mayor to sign developer's agreement with Bertand Chafee Hospital to construct service connections for a Medical Arts facility upon approval of Village attorney and Village Administrator. Agreement clarifies Village, ECDOH and NYDEC requirements to construct utility connections for water, sanitary sewer and electric services.

**Electric Report:**

Erie County Director of Energy and Management inquired if the Village would be interested in partnering or supporting a TAP grant application with SGI for electric school bus program. Purpose of the grant is it might be a way to upgrade grid infrastructure, provide a measure of grid resiliency, provide zero-emission transportation and get the infrastructure set up for future electrification of the school transportation. The grant should take the edge off of the premium for electric buses and the associated upgrades.

Will plan a meeting to discuss application and collect more information with SGI & EC if Village Board has interest.

**Streets report:**
