Public Informational Meeting on TAP Grant Project
Monday April 2, 2018 at 7:01 pm at 65 Franklin St – second floor during the Village Board Meeting.

Please come to the meeting for a presentation from our consultant, Watts Engineering, on the Bike Walk Project for the Village of Springville.

The Springville Bike Walk Enhancement project is a locally administered, federal aid project sponsored by the Village of Springville and is included in the Transportation Alternative Program (TAP). The TAP is a federal reimbursement program directed by the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT, Project Identification Number, PIN 5762.29). The proposed project is in the preliminary design phase. Improvements under consideration include new sidewalk and signs and pavement markings to provide for pedestrian access on Maple Avenue, Newman Street and South Buffalo Street, and to improve safety. Pedestrian-crossing improvements are being considered at 13 intersections on South and North Buffalo Street, Franklin Street, Maple Avenue and Newman Street, as well as bicycle enhancement features. The project may also include tree plantings and the installation of wooden bollards and bicycle racks.
