TAX WARRANT

You are hereby commanded to receive and collect from the several persons named in the Tax Roll hereunto annexed, the several sums stated in the last column hereof opposite their respective names, being a total \$1,921,494 for the following purpose:

You are further commanded to receive and collect such sums without additional charge between the first day of June and the second day of July, 2018 both inclusive; and thereafter to collect with such of the sums as have not been therefore collected and additional charge of seven and one-half per centum for the first month or fraction thereof, and one and one-half per centum for each month or fraction thereof until paid.

You are further commanded to file the tax roll and warrant in your office on or before the thirty-first day of October, 2018 and to deliver to the Board of Trustees at the same time an account of the taxes remaining due and unpaid; describing each parcel of real property upon which taxes are unpaid, showing the person or persons to whom the parcel is assessed and showing as to each parcel the amount of tax unpaid.
