Mayor Krebs called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1. Minutes Minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 11, 2016 were approved as written by motion of Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Wikman and Moriarty voting yes, Trustee Skelton abstaining, none opposed.

Minutes of the Executive Session of July 11, 2016 were approved as written by motion of Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Wikman and Moriarty voting yes, Trustee Skelton abstaining, none opposed.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There was no public comment this evening.

**DEPARTMENT REPORTS
ADMINISTRATOR REPORT**

2. Heritage Park Bid Results After explanation from Administrator Melock, motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Wikman voting yes, none opposed to rejecting the one bid from Nova Site Company for the Heritage Park Project. The bid was in the amount of \$770,862 which is over the budget approved for the project.

Furthermore, motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Wikman, Chamberlin and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to approving September 2, 2016 at 1:00 pm at the Village Office at 5 W. Main St., Springville as the time and date of the rebid for the Heritage Park Project.

3. CFA Project - Revitalization Grant Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustee Skelton, Wikman, Chamberlin and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to approve the completion of the SEQR form to create a plan in the CFA Project - Revitalization Grant.

Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Wikman voting yes, none opposed to naming the Village of Springville as the Lead Agency on the CFA Project – Revitalization Grant as well as declaring a negative declaration on the project.

At this time Administrator Melock informed everyone of the findings of the Computel Company. It was determined that Time Warner was paying the incorrect amount for their franchise fees (3% vs. 5%) and therefore underpaid the Village by over \$77,000. The Village will receive 60% of the undercharged amount with Computel receiving a 40% one- time payment. Time Warner’s future franchise fees will be recalculated to the correct amount of 5%.
