The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM.

PUBLIC HEARING

Mayor Krebs opened the duly advertised Public Hearing regarding the annexation request of the ROLOC Corporation at 14063 Route 219, SBL # 347.00-1-15.22, portion per attached legal description & map (A.1). Village Attorney Paul Weiss addressed the petition of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Shaver, owners of aforementioned property. The petition request is in compliance with General Municipal Law, Article 17. Mr. Weiss explained that if there are costs regarding surveying of the concerned property the Village of Springville will not pay those costs, they will be the responsibility of the owner. Administrator Melock explained that Doug Turner of Erie County Tax Mapping stated that the Village needed to do another survey showing the property now in the Village boundaries. After discussion and there being no objections to this request Mayor Krebs called for a vote. Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Moriarty;

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carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Moriarty, Chamberlin and Wikman voting yes, none opposed with proceeding and allowing the annexation of SBL# 347.00-1-15.22
At this time Supervisor Eppolito called for a vote. Supervisor Eppolito, Councilmen Drake, Snyder, Krezmien and Zittle voting yes, none opposed with proceeding and allowing the annexation of SBL# 347.00-1-15.22, 14063 Route 219, into the Village of Springville.

There being no further questions, comments or discussion Mayor Krebs and Supervisor Eppolito closed the public hearing.
