Motion was made by Mayor Krebs, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Braman, Pazzuti and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to reappointing Officer in Charge Nicholas Budney effective June 26, 2021.

4. Bid Awards

Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Pazzuti; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Pazzuti, Braman and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to award the bid (7 bids received) for a new wheeled loader to George & Swede Sales for the price of \$59,900 including trade in.

Motion was made by Trustee Braman, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Braman, Wikman, Pazzuti and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the bid (2 bids received) re a new 1 ton dump truck with plow for the Streets Division to Jim Murphy Chevy for the price of \$37,654 including trade in.

Motion was made by Trustee Braman, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Braman, Wikman, Pazzuti and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the contract for a new and unused backhoe to Milton Cat for the price of \$69,895 including trade in. This will be split 85% to water fund and 15% to sewer fund.

Motion was made by Trustee Braman, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Braman, Wikman, Pazzuti and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to awarding the sale of scrap surplus transformers (3/19/21 and 10/7/19) to MRC Disposal for \$1,715. This was the high bid. **060721 A.2**

- The ramps from the skate park are up for auction on Auction International, DPW-NY#25129. The bidding will end June 17th. Removal date is before June 21st – June 24th.
- The fence at the skatepark will be out on June 21st and the blacktop is scheduled to be removed on June 26th.
