Mayor Krebs called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1. Minutes Minutes of the Regular Meeting of February 20, 2018 were approved as corrected by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Chamberlin, Skelton and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed.

PUBLIC HEARING

2. 18/19 Preliminary Budget Mayor Krebs opened the duly advertised Public Hearing to discuss the proposed 18/19 Budget. Mayor Krebs presented a power point explanation of the General Fund Proposed Budget. After discussion and there being no further question motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to set the 2018/2019 Village of Springville tax rate at \$17.26, per thousand, representing a 1.6% increase over last year, and to adopt the proposed 2018/2019 budget as follows:

At this time Administrator Melock informed everyone that the Village General election absentee ballots were mailed today and a reminder that the election is on March 20th, noon to 9pm.

SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

Superintendent Kostowniak updated everyone on the following;

- Village water /sewer department has completed inspection of every sanitary sewer manhole in our system and identified several in need of immediate repair.
- Flow monitoring has finished and engineer is compiling data.
- SPEDS permit must be done for the WWTP
- March 2nd storm update
 - Electric mutual aid requests
 - Streets division

- 4. Lineman B Promotion Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustee Wikman, Skelton, Chamberlin and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to promoting Jessie Krezmien to Lineman B and his rate will increase to \$26.62 per hour. Jessie will complete his fourth year as Lineman B Apprentice on 2/24 /18.
- 5. Shared Service Agreement After explanation from Superintendent Kostowniak, motion was made by Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Wikman, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to recommend Mayor to sign a shared service agreement with Springville Griffith Central School Institute for Village Streets Division to clean out storm sewer drain structures. SGI will be invoiced \$125 dollars per structure, for 2 laborers and the street sweeper (vac truck) usage.
