Mayor Krebs called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

1. Minutes Minutes of the Regular Meeting of July 10, 2017 were approved as written by Trustee Chamberlin, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin and Wikman voting yes, none opposed, Trustees Moriarty and Skelton abstaining.

**ADMINISTRATOR REPORT**

2. Part-time Caretaker Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to approving the hiring of Adam Tillinghast to the position of part time caretaker effective August 15, 2017 for 15 hours at a rate of \$15.00 per hour.

SGI Homecoming Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Chamberlin, Wikman, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to approving the SGI Annual Homecoming Parade on Friday, September 15, 2017 at 5:30 pm.
4. Article 7 Tax Challenge After explanation by Administrator Melock, motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Moriarty; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Moriarty, Chamberlin and Wikman voting yes, none opposed to Village Attorney Paul Weiss attending the Article 7 tax challenge by the owners of 27 Franklin St. (335.16-1-33.1) to held on 8/31/17 at 9:30 am.

Administrator Melock updated everyone on the following;

- Requests for proposals for the CFA Grant will be sent out in the next couple of weeks.
- The Village's ambulance Certificate of Need (CON) expires in January 1, 2018 and the matter is being reviewed.

#### **SUPERINTENDENT REPORT**

Superintendent Kostowniak took a moment to update everyone on the following;

- Removal of hazardous tree in Fiddlers Green Park – DPW will replace with two new Crimson Maple trees.
- Transformer issue @ North Central Substation – oil moisture levels unacceptable – needs immediate oil replacement or reconditioning, transformer was purchased used condition and has been in use for 37 years. Bi-annual oil testing has shown sharp decline out or operation specifications. Researching the purchase of an oil dehydrator and filter system, both mobile and passive.
- Ribbon cutting at 65 Franklin Street and Heritage Park will be the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> week of September.
- Restroom building has been installed, DPW is completing service connections. Restroom will be open to the public in a few weeks. The restroom will have a magnetic locking system to only allow access from 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and open May 15<sup>th</sup> to October 1.

5. Transformer Repair/Replace Bid Ad Following the above explanation by Superintendent Kostowniak, motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Wikman voting yes, none opposed to recommend authorization to advertise for sealed bids for oil reconditioning / repair, or purchase of equipment to maintain 3,750 kVa rated transformers within the Village Electric transmission as recommended by Village Electrical Engineer.
