Mayor Krebs called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

All attending observed a moment of silence for the victims of the Las Vegas shooting and storm victims.

1. Minutes Minutes of the Regular Meeting of September 11, 2017 were approved as written by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton, carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Moriarty and Chamberlin voting yes, none opposed.

PUBLIC HEARING

2. 2018 CDBG Application Mayor Krebs opened the public hearing regarding the 2018 Community Development Block Grant application. After discussion and there being no comment from those attending the meeting, Mayor Krebs closed the public hearing.

Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Wikman; carried, Mayor Krebs Trustees Skelton, Wikman, Chamberlin and Moriarty voting yes, none opposed to approving the below the 2018 CDBG application for the projects listed below. The dollar amounts for the below projects will be available at the October 16th meeting.

2. Waterline replacement along Central Avenue
3. Rural Transit service

3. LL 2017-6 Chapter 110 Updates Mayor Krebs opened the public hearing regarding LL 2017-6, Chapter 110 – Amendments to Licenses and Permits. During discussion it was outlined that the background checks will cost \$150 per applicant annually (6/1 – 5/31) as well as required fingerprinting . Motion was made by Trustee Skelton, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Skelton, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Wikman voting yes, none opposed to closing the public hearing regarding the below amendments to Chapter 110.

DEPARTMENT REPORTS

ADMINISTRATOR REPORT

4. LL 2017-6 Motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Chamberlin; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Chamberlin, Moriarty and Skelton voting yes, none opposed to passing LL 2017-6 as shown below.

Proposed Local Law 2017 – Chapter 110 -Amendments to Licenses and Permits

Current Language Section 110-7 Applications – The Village Board of Trustees shall approve, by resolution applications for licenses.

New language Section 110-7 Applications – No license shall be issued until an application has been first filed with the Village Clerk by the person seeking the same. Where a person makes application for j=himself and one or more helpers, applicable personal information specified on the application form shall be required to be given for each applicant and helper. An individual license shall be required by each party. No license issued under this article shall be transferable from one person to another. The application shall be issued from the clerk’s office. The completed application may be referred to the Village of Springville Police for approval. The Village Administrator shall approve the licenses. Current Language Section 110-8 – A- Investigations – The officers charged with the duty of performing the investigation shall make a report thereon to the Board of Trustees...

New language Section 110-8 – A- Investigations - replace Board of Trustees with Village Administrator
New Language Section 110-8 Add Paragraph C-E

C. The police officer designated by the Officer in Charge to order and review criminal records (“Criminal Records Officer”) may cause the fingerprints of any applicant for a peddling or soliciting permit (license) and any applicable fee to be forwarded to the Division of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS) in the form and manner as prescribed by DCJS for a complete criminal background and investigation upon receipt of the appropriate fee from the applicant.

D. The Criminal Records Officer, the Village Administrator and the Village Attorney shall review the criminal history record information (CHRI) disseminated by DCJS in connection with the applicant’s criminal background and investigation.

E. In making the determination of the applicant’s fitness for the requested permit (license), based upon the information provided by DCJS, New York State Correction Law Section 701 through 703b and Section 751 through 753 shall be given due consideration.

5. Cattaraugus Street Water District Flushing After discussion, motion was made by Trustee Wikman, seconded by Trustee Skelton; carried, Mayor Krebs, Trustees Wikman, Skelton, Moriarty and Chamberlin voting yes, none opposed to approving the below Intermunicipal Agreement regarding the flushing of water lines for the Cattaraugus Street Water District.

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INTERMUNICIPAL AGREEMENT
FLUSHING OF WATER LINE FOR CATTARAUGUS STREET WATER DISTRICT

This Agreement, made pursuant to New York State General Municipal Law Section 109 and entered into this _____ day of October, 2017 between the Village of Springville (the "Village"), a municipal subdivision of the State of New York, located at 5 West Main Street, Springville, New York, 14141, and the Town of Concord (the "Town"), a municipal subdivision of the State of New York acting for on behalf of a water district designated The Cattaraugus Street Water District (the "District"), located at 86 Franklin Street, Springville, New York 14141.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Town is responsible for the cost of any required repairs and maintenance of the customer meters and all piping, hydrants, valves, etc. within the District per Section 1.4 of the Intermunicipal Water Sales Agreement signed January 2, 2014 between the Village and Town.

WHEREAS, The Town has asked the Village to flush the service line for the District and the Village is agreeable to this request with the following stipulations:

1. The Village will flush the District line on the same line flushing schedule as the Village water lines which are currently three times a year.
2. The Town will pay the Village the cost to flush the District line on an annual basis after receipt of an invoice from the Village.
3. The cost to the Town by the Village to flush the District line is currently \$95 per time flushed or \$285 annually. This rate will increase by 3% or the cost incurred, whichever is higher each year after the initial year of this agreement.

WHEREAS, this Agreement shall be for a term of one (1) year and shall automatically be renewed annually, unless terminated by either party with a 60 day written notice of termination to the other party.

WHEREAS, the Town shall indemnify and hold harmless the Village, its agents, officers, and employees for any damages, claims and /or losses, including attorneys' fees and expenses, to the Village resulting from damage to the Town's water district facilities resulting from flushing of the District line.

NOW, THEREFORE in consideration of the mutual Agreement each to the other herein contained, and in accordance with New York State Law, the Village agrees to flush the District water line upon terms and conditions set forth herein. This Agreement constitutes the complete understanding of the parties. No modifications of any provisions thereof shall be valid unless in writing and signed by both parties.

SBL # 335.10-2-50 (9 Spas Dr.) had \$142.10 relieved on it for a unpaid water & sewer which was paid for in utilities. Approval to remove the \$142.10 relevy.
