Use this application if you would like to receive an early mail ballot to submit before election day. All ballots must be submitted before 9 pm on election day in order to be canvassed.

Complete the sections in the application and sign and date the application.

Once the application is completed and signed, return the original to the Village of Springville Clerk's Office in person at 5 W. Main St Springville, NY 14141 during the hours of 8 am till 4 pm Monday-Friday or place the completed and signed original in the utility drop box on the front of 5 W. Main St (near Joylan Theater side). In person applications must be received no later than the day before elections, which would be March 18, 2024.

If you are mailing the application please mail to Village of Springville Clerk's Office, PO Box 17, Springville, NY 14141. If the application is submitted by mail, then the application must be received by the Village Clerk's office no later than March 12, 2024.
